

## SECONDARY SCHOOLS ENTRANCE EXAMINATION –

### FOR FIELDS OF STUDY COMPLETED BY THE MATURITA EXAMINATION

FOR FOREIGNERS WHO HAVE BEEN GRANTED TEMPORARY PROTECTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ACT ON SOME OF THE MEASURES ASSOCIATED WITH THE ARMED CONFLICT WITHIN THE TERRITORY OF UKRAINE

#### PROCEDURE FOR THE MATHEMATICS EXAMINATION

- The mathematics examination will always start at **8.30 a.m.** on the given day. Be sure to arrive to the school sufficiently in advance according to the instructions provided in the invitation.
- During the examination, you will be seated at desks in a classroom, individually, one behind the other. Place your writing and drawing implements on your desk. You can place your watch on the other side of your desk to allow you to keep track of the time. You may eat and drink during the examination, but neither food nor drink may be placed on the desk. Therefore, place everything other than the permitted implements in your bag or backpack. Completely turn off your mobile phone before putting it in your bag or backpack: it is not sufficient to merely put it on silent mode.
- Prior to the start of the examination, the teacher will hand out **the answer sheet, the test booklet and some extra sheets of paper** for note-taking and auxiliary calculations, and will ask you to sign the attendance sheet.
- You can find basic information on the examination and instructions on how to fill in the answer sheet on **the front page of the test booklet**. The information will be provided in Czech, Ukrainian or English according to the language that you selected in your application.
- On the last page of the test booklet for four-year fields of study, you will find selected mathematical formulae and facts.
- When sitting the examination, you can **only use a blue or black ballpoint pen, a regular pencil and drawing implements** (a ruler, a set square, compasses, a protractor, etc.). During the exam, you are not allowed to use a calculator, any mathematics textbook or publication which contains mathematical formulae. The use of a mobile phone, smart watch or any other communication devices is strictly prohibited.
- The mathematics examination lasts **90 minutes** and you can earn the maximum of **50 points**. The examination contains both, open-ended and multiple-choice questions. In the multiple-choice questions, only one of the offered answers is correct for each question or sub-question.
- The examinations for four-year and six-year fields of study may include tasks which require you to show the entire working. As such, you will not be awarded any points for them, if you only state the result without showing your working.
- **Write** your answers **clearly on the answer sheet** using a blue or black ballpoint pen. In the geometry questions, use a pencil to make the necessary drawings and then trace everything with a ballpoint pen. Any ambiguous or illegible answers will be considered to be incorrect.
- You are allowed to take notes in the test booklet or on the extra sheets of paper, however, these will not be marked.
- The teacher will write the examination's start and end times on a board. You will be notified of the approaching end of the examination ten and five minutes before the end. **Don't forget to transfer all your answers on the answer sheet before the time limit expires.**

- If you wish to leave the classroom prior to the end of the examination, you may do so, however, you will not be permitted to return. Medical reasons for leaving the room constitute an exception to this and will be dealt with on an individual basis.
- Upon completion of the examination, you can raise any serious objections regarding the way the examination had been administered in the classroom.
